

Vendor Space at the 2022 Sanders County Fair **September 1-4**

Individuals and companies, both for-profit and non-profit, which participated in the 2021 Sanders County Fair & Rodeo, are provided a "Commercial or Non-Profit Vendor Space Reservation Form" to facilitate your participation in the 2022 fair. A map of the Vendor's Midway (not to scale) is included and depicts the available vendor spaces. The space assigned to you last year will be your returning spot unless otherwise requested. **Please complete the space reservation form in its entirety, specifying what products you will be selling.**

Return the completed form, with payment in full, no later than June 03, 2022. Spaces not paid for at that time will be released to other vendors on our waiting list; there are NO exceptions to this Fair Commission rule.

Vendors may cancel their space reservation and receive a full refund up to **July 22nd**. If you cancel after that date, there will be no refund issued.

Parking fees: If your vehicle will fit within your leased space, and stays parked for the duration of the entire fair, there is no parking fee. However, if you have any additional vehicles, or don't remain permanently parked, you will have to pay a daily parking fee or you may purchase a weekly parking permit which covers the entire week of the fair. The fair runs from Thursday, September 1st through Sunday, September 4th, 2022

Vendors are required to be set-up no later than 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 31st. You may set-up prior to the 31st of August if you desire. Arena events begin on Thursday, September 1st. Prior to that time, most activities involve open class and 4-H entries being brought to the fairgrounds, displayed and judged.

Please be advised that there are no dogs allowed on the fairgrounds! They can be in and around your campsite but are not to be on the midway.

Due to the large crowds on Sunday, tear down and departure is not permitted for those vendors along the main fire lanes. Those vendors on the Vendor's Midway who have access to the vendor gate, may depart after 6:00 p.m. on Sunday if they do not venture onto any fire lane.

The Sanders County Fair provides roaming security patrols throughout the night, but does not guarantee the security of your vendor space or its contents. Safeguarding your product is your responsibility

Weapons (guns, knives, etc.) and products of an illegal, immoral or pornographic nature are prohibited, as is silly string or fake cigarettes. This is a family-oriented fair and such products are not welcome. Please abide by these guidelines. We remain a family friendly event and if we have issues with any vendors and you are asked to leave you will not return for future events.
