

# Sanders County Fair 2024 Commercial Vendor Space

(Does not include food Vendors)

## August 29<sup>th</sup> - September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024

Individuals and companies, both for profit and non-profit, which participated in the 2023 Sanders County Fair & PRCA Rodeo, are being provided a "Commercial or Non-Profit Vendor Space Reservation Form" to facilitate your participation in the 2024 Fair. A map of the Vendor's Midway (not to scale) is included and depicts the available vendor spaces. The space assigned to you last year will be your returning spot unless otherwise requested. Please complete the space reservation form in its entirety, specifying what products you will be selling.

Please return the completed form, along with your payment in full, **no later than June 3, 2024**. Spaces not paid for at that time will be released to other vendors on our waiting list. There are **No Exceptions** to this Fair Commission Rule. **Vendors may cancel their space reservation and receive a full refund up until July 22, 2024. If you cancel after this date, there will be no refund issued.**

**Parking:** If your vehicle will fit within your leased space, and stays parked for the duration of the entire fair, there will be no parking fee. Commercial vendors will be allotted One (1) free weekly parking permit; however, if you have additional vehicles, you will need to pay a daily parking fee or you may purchase an additional weekly parking permit, which covers the entire week of the fair. The fair week runs from Thursday August 29<sup>th</sup> through Sunday September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024.

**Vendors are required to be set up no later than six (6:00 pm) on Wednesday August 28, 2024.** You may also set up prior to this time if you desire. The arena events will begin on Thursday August 29<sup>th</sup> and prior to that time, most activities involve open class and 4-H entries being brought in to the fairgrounds, are being displayed, and being judged.

Due to the large crowds on Sunday, tear down and departure is not permitted for those vendors along the main fire lanes. Those vendors on the Vendor's Midway who have access to the vendor gate, may depart after six (6:00 pm) on Sunday if they choose to as long as they do not go onto any fire lanes.

**\*\*\*Please note that there are No Dogs allowed on the Fairgrounds with the exception of Service Dogs. Your dog may stay in and around your campsite, but are not allowed on the midway. If you have a Service Dog, they may stay in your booth at all times until you leave the fairgrounds for the day.**

The Sanders County Fair provides roaming security patrols throughout the night, but does not guarantee the security of your vendor space or its contents. Safeguarding your products are your responsibility.

Weapons, such as guns, knives, etc., and products of an illegal, immoral or pornographic nature are prohibited, as is string or fake cigarettes. This is a family oriented fair and such products are not welcome. We will remain a family friendly event and if we have issues with any vendors, you will be asked to leave and will not be able to return to any future events. Please abide by these guidelines...
