ENTRY FEES:

Day of Show \$8.00/class + Office fee/rider \$3.00

Pre-Entry \$5.00/class + Office fee \$2.00

\$35.00 Ride All Day per horse/rider combo (includes office fee)

\$30.00 Ride All Day for 4-H Members (includes office fee)

Pre-Entries may be made any time before the day of the show to eliminate delay in beginning the show. Email & phone entries are encouraged. (call or text)

Entries close @ 8:30 am the day of the show. Entries refunded only with vet certification.

Vaccination Request: It is highly recommended to have all horse vaccinated for at least the following: Flu, Rhino, Tetanus, WEE/VEE, and Strangles.

Novice Youth Riders is open to youth 13 & Under that are beginner riders and/or new to horse showing. Novice Youth will show at a walk and jog/trot only. Lope/canter may cause elimination. Rider may cross enter in the Novice Rider/Horse classes.

Novice Rider/Horse is open to any age rider or horse that is truly a beginner or new to horse showing. This class will be shown at a walk, jog/trot and lope/canter. Riders 14 years and over may not cross enter in other divisions.

Ribbons/Points will be awarded to 5 places. Points are awarded as follows: 1st – 5 points, 2nd – 4 points, 3rd – 3 points, 4th – 2 points; 5th – 1 point, in classes with five or more entries. If less than five entries, points will be awarded with first place receiving points equal to the number in the class, second one point less. (For example, a class of 4 horses: 1st – 4 points, 2nd – 3 points, etc)

Equitation Classes will not have a posted pattern. It is up to judge's discretion to call for a pattern in the class.

High Point Awards will be given in the following categories.

Listed are the classes that count towards that high point.

Novice Youth Rider – halter (class 1 or 2), 4, 10, 14, 18, 22, 26, 30, 33

Novice Rider/Horse - halter (class 1, 2 or 3), 5, 11, 15, 19, 23, 27, 30, 33

17 & Under Rider - halter (class 1 or 2), 6, 12, 16, 20, 24, 28, 31, 34

18 & Over Rider - halter (class 1, 2 or 3), 7, 13, 17, 21, 25, 29, 32, 35

***Must show in at least 5 classes to qualify for high point awards.**

***Ties will be broken by place/participation in showmanship.**

- Overnight camping is available.
- Stalls may be available, but you need to call ahead and reserve your pen.
- Dry camping is available.
- Any class that does not have 3 entries may be canceled or combined.
- Showmanship patterns will be posted one hour prior to class time.
- Rider's age determined as of January 1, 2018.
- No stallions may be handled by anyone under age 18.
- JUDGES DECISIONS ARE FINAL.
